When: Saturday & Sunday, September 10th & 11th, 2016
Saturday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm
Sunday, 9:00 am to 4:30 pm
(Attendance is required both days)

Where: Club house & firing ranges at the Portage Lake Sportsmen's Club
Located 3½ miles west of Chassell on the Chassell-Painesdale Rd
(Chassell-Painesdale Road is called Fifth St in Chassell)

Cost: \$10 which covers the cost of ammunition, eye & ear protection,
range fees, and refreshments.

Pre-Registration is Required. To pre-register phone Ed at 906-231-6004.

Students should come prepared to be outside in rain, sleet, or just plain cool weather.

Students should bring their own lunch and snacks.

Students may not bring ammunition or firearms to the class.

Persons of any age may attend this Hunter Education course. Adult students are welcome. Recommended minimum age is 10. Students under the age of 10 must have a parent or guardian present during the course.

All adult students and a parent or guardian of all minor students must sign an Agreement Form prior to starting the hunter education course. Forms will be available on Saturday morning. Parents are welcome to observe all aspects of the Hunter Education course.
