Persons of any age may attend Hunter Education. Recommended minimum age is 10.
Students under the age of 10 must have a parent/guardian present during the course.

Students or Parents may not bring ammunition or firearms to the class.

Adult students and a parent or guardian of a minor must sign an Agreement Form prior
to the Hunter Education course; forms will be available on Saturday morning.
